MINUTES OF REGULAR COMMISSION MEETING August 28, 2018 3:00 p.m.

- 1. The meeting was held at the District Building at 3:00 PM on August 28th, 2018 present were: Commissioners Lynn Aibejeris, Steve Brown, Gennie Malone, Roger Weste, and Willi Huxford. Commissioner Nancy Geohagan was absent. TCW&SD STAFF present were: Diane Carlton, Lynette Senter, Kristi Woods, Ron Bennett, and David Morgan. Chairman Aibejeris called the meeting to order at 3:00 p.m. and declared a quorum present.
- 2. Commissioner Steve Brown led in prayer and the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
- 3. Guests present were Trevor Burch with Dewberry, County Commissioner Steve Spradley, Kenda Robinson with USDA, Glenn Senter, Michael E. Newberry, Charles Carlton, and Carrie Sue & Roy Taylor.
- 4. Lynette Senter introduced the new Billing Clerk, Kristi Woods.
- 5. Steve Spradley, County Commissioner for our District spoke with the Board regarding the County's budget process and the installation of the Pipeline at the Fenholloway River.
- 6. Trevor Burch of Dewberry spoke about continuing the work on the Water Improvements PER. He hopes to have a draft available for review by mid to late September to be ready for the coming funding cycle in November. Trevor has discovered that the original proposed closed loop system is not feasible. He has suggested going with an auto flushing system on controlled cycles as a better and more affordable option. He is also working on a proposal for a larger tank size of 250,000 gallons.
- 7. Kenda Robinson with USDA spoke about financing the Water Improvement Project. She provided the office and the board with descriptions of the financing opportunities available and will later meet with the office staff to discuss setting the District up to complete the online paperwork.
- 8. Approval of minutes for the regular commission meeting July 24, 2018. Chairman Aibejeris asked if everyone had reviewed the minutes and if there was a motion to approve. Commissioner Weste made a motion to accept the minutes. Commissioner Malone offered a second. Chairman Aibejeris asked for further discussion. There was none. By unanimous vote the motion was approved.

9. Staff and Committee Reports

- a. Director Report Diane Carlton Diane reported the Water and Sewer sales for July were over the budgeted amount. There were no turned off accounts, no past due accounts, and one new membership. The adjustments for the month totaled \$619.35. There were no questions from the commissioners. Chairman Aibejeris called for a motion to accept the Director's Report as given. Commissioner Huxford made a motion to accept the Director's Report as presented. Commissioner Brown offered a second. Chairman Aibejeris called for further discussion. There was none. By unanimous vote the motion was approved.
- b. Other Assistant Office Manager Items Diane Carlton None
- c. Financial Reports Lynette Senter Lynette reported that water and sewer sales for the month of July 2018 were \$51,256.37. Total expenses were \$24,194.10. We received \$7,880.00 in other income which included \$6,000.00 for customer grinder pump sales and \$1,875.37 miscellaneous income. The net income for the month was \$34,942.27. There were no questions from the commissioners. Chairman Aibejeris called for a motion to accept the Financial Report as given. Commissioner Malone made a motion to accept the Financial Reports as given. Commissioner Weste offered a second. Chairman Aibejeris called for further discussion. There was none. By unanimous vote the motion was approved.

d. Other Office Manager Items- Lynette Senter – Lynette confirmed that the transfers from Savings to Checking for the USDA Interest and Principal Loan amounts were completed. USDA will deduct the total of \$79,549.79 on or about September 1, 2018. The District was contacted by Danny Griner from Taylor County who informed us that a new property owner started the application process for a power pole and was mistakenly informed by his office that they were only required to obtain a pump-out contract. When the customer returned to the County to obtain his permit, Danny caught the error and explained that in the coastal high hazard area/Taylor Coastal Water & Sewer District area, a grinder pump and water service are necessary. The customer tried to argue with Danny about the County regulations versus the District's regulations and Danny notified us of the discrepancy. We provided Danny with the information from Conrad Bishop regarding mandatory hook ups, and also let Danny know that this particular customer had already visited our offices and obtained the required forms prior to going to the County. The customer had initially requested that he be put on the agenda for the Building & Planning Board, but Danny indicated that no further contact with the customer had been received.

10. New Business

- a. Diane Carlton has applied for the vacant board member spot.
- b. Approval of the 2018-19 rate increase of 2.5%. This will increase the average monthly bill from \$85.34 to \$87.16 \$1.82. Commissioner Huxford made a motion to approve the rate increase. Commissioner Malone seconded the motion. Chairman Aibejeris called for further discussion. There was none. By unanimous vote the motion was approved
